In recognition of Volunteer Week (May 14 - 20) the club will honour a volunteer from a registered, charitable organization, and present an award of **\$2000** to that organization.

The award dinner and presentation will take place on **Thursday, May 24, 2012** at 6:00 p.m. at a location to be determined.

NOMINATION GUIDE

- A successful applicant will be an individual who has given outstanding volunteer service for a minimum of five (5) years to one or more registered, charitable agencies working in the London area and who exemplifies selfless dedication to the needs of their fellow citizens.
- A committee of the Kiwanis Club of North London will select the recipient from among the nominees. The award recipient's commitment to volunteerism will be recognized by the club and the charity will receive \$2000 to be used to further their successful work in the community.
- The award recipient and his/her organization will be honoured at an award banquet and receive public recognition in the media.

THE J. DOUGLAS EARTHY COMMUNITY SERVICE AWARD

- SPONSOR:** The **Kiwanis Club of North London** established the award to honour long-time member Doug Earthy. The award is designed to raise awareness of the vital contribution that volunteers make to the London community as well as to recognize annually special volunteers and their organizations.
- FUNDING:** An endowment has been set up through **London Community Foundation** which manages the fund. Annually, the income from the fund will provide the award. It is expected that donations from individuals will add to the endowment fund and award.
- RECIPIENTS:** The recipient of the monetary award of \$2000 will be selected from London and area registered charitable organizations and youth sports associations to honour a volunteer active with that organization or association. The volunteer will receive a certificate to commemorate the award.
- SELECTION:** A selection committee of members from the Kiwanis Club of North London will review the nominations and will select the recipient annually based on the established criteria.
- AWARD CRITERIA:** An award recipient will be a person who has given outstanding volunteer service for at least five years to one or more recognized organizations providing community service within the London area. Special consideration will be given to volunteers with exemplary service in more than one organization.
- The nomination for the award can be initiated by either an organization or an individual.
- The selection committee reserves the right to verify the information submitted.
- The Kiwanis Club of North London reserves the right not to present the awards in any given year if, in the opinion of the selection committee, no nominees meet the selection criteria.
- PUBLICITY:** In conjunction with London Community Foundation, the award recipient will be announced annually through the London media.
